# Welcome to the proposed nation of HAMON



## 1. AIM

The Nation of Hamon is proposed as a joint engineering initiative to create new land in a region of multiple small islands with moderate climate. Hamon is bounded by a 300km radius centred at Latitude 9°33'7.61"N, Longitude 112°53'49.48"E. This proposal seeks to cast a new light on what has been a contentious region, but which has the potential to be a live demonstration of how diverse interests can work together cooperatively for the constructive benefit of all.

## 2. FOUNDING COUNTRIES

The Hamon six “Founding Countries” are Brunei, China, Malaysia, Philippines, Taiwan and Vietnam.

## 3. AMBITION

Hamon is a nation designed to provide extensive newly formed dry land and natural resources for the beneficial use of its inhabitants.

## 4. INDUSTRY

Hamon is a centre for education, wellness, communication, science, engineering, research, fishing, farming, mining, and tourism. History is not studied at Hamon education facilities as it is a newly created nation designed to be forward focussed and to develop its own history.

Specific industrial emphasis is placed on:

- Marine mining
- Land reclamation
- Power supply
- Carbon dioxide sequestration in sea water
- Aquaculture and fishing
- Desalination
- Crop production

## 5. MANAGEMENT

Hamon is under the direction of an Administrator assisted by staff officers “The Administration”. Each Founding Country appoints an Administrator, or their replacement for a seven year term. Successive Administrators are appointed in alphabetical order of Founding Nations starting with Brunei. Each Administrator has a predominant education in an engineering discipline to reflect the ongoing construction nature of Hamon. The Administrator controls the Administration and is responsible for its operations.

## 6. SOCIETY

Hamon is a non religious society where rules of habitation include:

- Respect for extended families.
- Respect for the office of The Administration.
- Respect for human and property rights.
- The common language is Australian English.
- Rules of law may be proposed by the Administration from time to time. All laws are subject to ratification (or removal) by compulsory electronic polling of Hamon inhabitants requiring a 75% majority vote.
- All citizens carry dual nationality which permits the Administration to return unwelcome inhabitants to their second country of nationality, and to sell their assets.

## 7. LAND FORMATION

New land is constructed by importing or dredging clean fill material, as concurred by the Administration. A register is kept of the volume of material provided and by whom. An inherent value is placed on the fill and a “fill credit” entry established.

## 8. ECONOMY

- Hamon surface land is offered under freehold title sale by open auction, payable in gold bullion to the Administration.
- The gold bullion is safely stored in equal portions by each of the six Founding Countries.
- The bullion price paid is reduced by any “fill credit” the purchaser is entitled to.
- Existing long term inhabitants (families) are offered freehold title to the surface at their current place of residence, at no cost.
- The Administration retains ownership of the land subsurface and marine assets and licenses these assets for harvesting or extraction purposes.
- Local currency is created and backed by gold.
- The ratio of currency to gold is never more than 75%.
- Tax is paid monthly to the Administration on all “income” (less wages paid) received by Hamon inhabitants at a flat percentage rate - to be determined by the Administration.
- “Income” includes any revenue received from the sale of natural resources harvested from within the Hamon boundary.
- No other taxes are payable.

## 9. BORDER SECURITY

Surveillance is secured with a fleet of high speed catamaran water craft assisted by drone aircraft under the control of the Administration.
